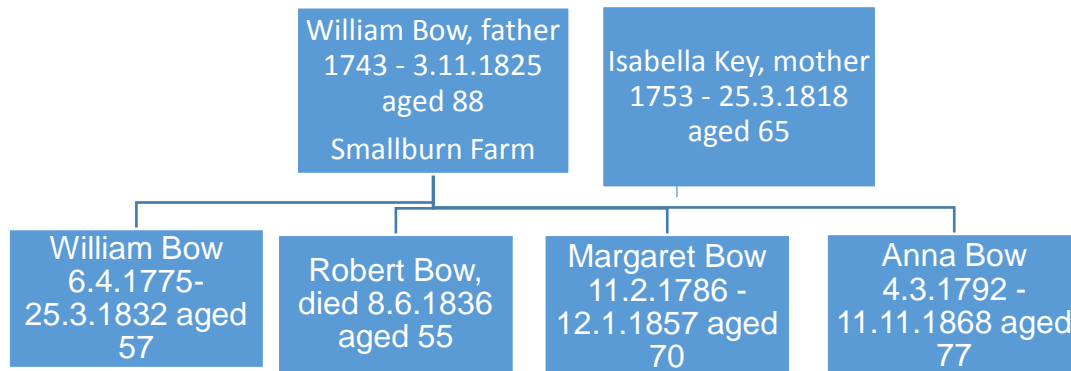


Appendix H: Bow family tree (gravestone¹⁴⁷)

This family had another son who was born approx. 1794 and died on 12.3.1870. As described in *Old Faces, Old Places and Old Stories of Stirling* (Drysdale, 1899, p. 138) Bailie Bow of Smallburn was first a haberdasher in Stirling. Mr Bow was elected Dean of guild and Councillor of the Burgh in 1821 and became a Magistrate in Stirling in 1826 and Senior Baillie from 1833-1836. Mr Bow died at his property Wright Park, near Kippen and is buried at Logie Cemetery. Mr Bow was described as “a man of strict integrity ... and his loss was sincerely regretted by all those who had the pleasure of his friendship” (Drysdale, 1899, p. 138).
